

Curriculum Overview: MFL

Principles and Purpose of the MFL Curriculum

At Trumpington, we want all our students to leave us as confident, creative, and competent communicators in French or Spanish with an appreciation of the cultural and linguistic diversity of the world.

We do this by sequencing vocabulary, grammar and phonics so knowledge builds term by term and year by year, with a focus on deepening and expanding linguistic competency. Language is never taught in isolation and topics are interleaved and links between common language and structures are highlighted. At Trumpington, we are offering both French and Spanish as our main taught language and this is why Year 7 currently study French but Year 8 are currently studying Spanish. We also offer the option of GCSE Spanish from scratch in Year 10 so students have the possibility to study two languages. The MFL curriculum presents both French and Spanish as global languages with a focus on the diverse communities and countries.

As we have a very diverse student population, the MFL department offers the opportunity to students to complete the GCSE in their home language (if the qualification exists) in Year 11. We believe that this gives students the chance to show their linguistic abilities and highlights the broad spectrum of languages spoken in Trumpington.

Why this, why now?

Our MFL Curriculum has been carefully sequenced to introduce students to the basics of both French and Spanish, including different grammatical tenses and vocabulary topics. Each year builds on the previous year in Key Stage 3 and then the topics are revisited at Key Stage 4.
